

Mr George Rose- Winter in Korea 1952

“...By the time we got there [Korea], the War had already started in ‘50, we didn’t get there until ‘52. By then they’d got the equipment and in the Winter we had parkas, fur-lined clothing which was zipped up and so on, quite comfortable.

I think the first people who went out in ‘50, they went from Hong Kong just wearing Battledress, well that was no good for the Winter. It was bitterly cold and we don’t have winters like that over here [UK]...”
