“...When we were in Egypt... well, what happened was they wanted people who had at least 15 months service to go to Korea. Well, we didn't really know what Korea was, never heard of it, we didn't even know there was a war there. All my friends were putting their names down so I put mine down. Somebody told me to never volunteer, but we did, and that's why we got transferred. About 30 of us came back. I don't regret that either, it was quite an interesting service. Going abroad was something interesting then. Those days we didn't go abroad anywhere...”
