Our Will and Pleasure is that out of such Monies as are or shall come to your hands for the use of Our Guards Garrisons and Land Forces you pay to Our Right Trusty and Wellbeloved Councell George Lord Dartmouth the Summe of two thousand two hundred eighty two pounds sixteen shillings and two pence the same being certified by you to be due to Our Royall Regiment of Fuziliers under his Command upon the Muster commencing the first day of January 1685 and ending the last day of February following. That you also pay to the said Lord Dartmouth the Summe of one hundred thirty five pounds four shillings and two pence upon an allowance of on Penny a day to each soldier of the said Regiment when upon Duty in Our Tower of London over and above Our Establishment for the same above-mentioned And for so doing this together with the Acquittances of the said L'd Dartmouth or his Asigned shall be your Warrt. And Discharge Given at Our Court of Whitehall on the 27th day of March 1686.
